All papers will be reviewed by the scientific committee. It is the editor's choice to accept a paper.

- Please send your paper as *.doc, formatted with all pictures/graphics/tables embedded at the right position. Title of the illustration directly under the illustration in 8point, referenced to as "*figure1 - ...*".
- There is no limit of pages or pictures/graphics/tables. Pictures/graphics/tables can be colour or greyscale.
- Paper size is A4. Use only one column, left-aligned, margins set like your preferred setup.
- Please use a sans serif font like Arial, Verdana etc. with line spacing 1.5 point. Use italic letters instead of bold or underline to highlight words.
- Structure of the paper as follows:

Paper Title 12point
Author 10point
Affiliation 10point
Abstract 10 point

Subtitles 12 point
Text 10point
Endnotes 8point
References 8point

- Use endnotes not footnotes. References as following examples:
